**And finally:-** The Gospel reading of this weekend reminds us of the need for integrity in the choices that we make. This is not only essential in our day to day dealings with others, involved as we all are in the affairs of this world, but also in our following of the Lord, and the teachings of His Church, in matters of faith. Yes it is true that for some, if not for all, some of the teachings of the Church – of Christ – may seem difficult, and dare I say it 'a little old fashioned'. But we cannot and must not approach matters of faith in a piece-meal way, choosing to accept and follow some whilst rejecting others. Following the Lord was never going to be easy, even He acknowledges this in His comments made to the disciples after His teachings on the Eucharist, but follow Him and His teachings we must if we are to "make our way into the Kingdom of Heaven". If we say "yes" to following Christ we must mean 'yes' – in all matters of faith as taught by the Church – and so we must pray for the strength to remain faithful even when we find our faith challenging.
