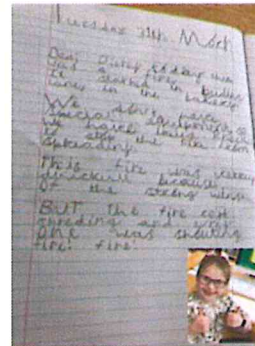


SUMMARY REPORTS

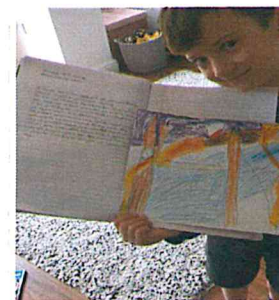
All staff have completed an Easter message for your class, which you will receive later on tomorrow. Please read them with your children— we hope it helps them to stay connected, at this difficult time.
