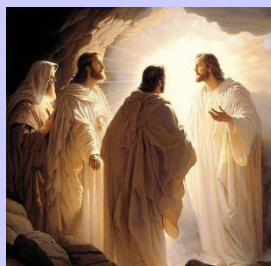

Dear Parents,

Lent started on Wednesday 14th February and, as is traditional, the children will be encouraged to live out their faith to help our chosen charities. This year the children have voted to support the charities CAFOD, Father Hudson's Homes and Cancer Research.

As part of the children's Lenten initiatives, the Mini Vinnies have voted to carry out three main fundraising initiatives to help both their local and global families.

Initiative 1 – Family Fast Day

On **Friday 1st March** all children will be encouraged to "Live Simply" through their choice of dinner and empathise with their global brothers and sisters, who do not have a lot of food to eat. On this day, the children will be able to opt for a simple lunch of soup, bread roll and a pudding to raise money for CAFOD. This can be booked in the usual way on School Gateway.

Initiative 2 – "Giving Friday"

As Lent is a time for prayer, fasting and almsgiving, the children would like to support the local foodbank by donating food and toiletries. Each Friday, children are asked to bring a small offering to show their solidarity for those in need. The focus will be different each week and will be as follows:

Friday 1st March - Toiletries

Friday 8th March - Easter Eggs

Friday 15th March - Tins

Friday 22nd March - Treats - biscuits, crisps, chocolate etc.

Initiative 3 – Spring Fair

On **Friday 15th March**, the Mini Vinnies will be organising a Spring fair with different fundraising stalls that will be arranged and run by each class. The Mini Vinnies hope that the classes will have fun planning, arranging and participating in the activities whilst being able to raise money for the needy and living out their faith through their actions and participation. More details on this will be shared once the classes have made their plans.

Please talk to your child about how you, as a family, can support these plans to show solidarity towards those in need. All donations and generosity will be gratefully received.
