And finally:- From the sublime to the ridiculous! Last weekend in the Gospel we heard our Lord say to St. Peter that it would be upon his profession of faith, his recognition of Jesus as "the Christ, the Son of the Living God" that He would "build [His] Church". Now, just a few verses on in the same chapter of the Gospel according to St. Mathew, St. Peter gets it so very wrong that it earns him one of the strongest rebukes found in the scriptures – "Get behind me Satan". Despite the many obvious, and at times very apparent, faults and failings of the closest disciples of the Lord, His Apostles, it was through them that the Good News of our salvation was proclaimed to the whole world; it was upon Peter that the Lord established His Church. For the truth is that the Lord knew their weaknesses even before He called them to be His followers, and in the end His choice of these twelve men proved good. Like them the Lord knows our faults and failings, and yet, He has called each one of us to be His disciples, to do for Him some specific service which only we can do.
