Walsall Falls Prevention have asked that we highlight the work that they do in helping raise the awareness of falls among people aged 50+, and to promote positive steps for staying active, remaining independent and generally enjoying life. As an organisation they work in partnership with Walsall NHS Trust and Walsall Sports and Leisure Services.

We are all at risk of falling – and falls account for more than half of hospital admissions for accidental injury.

You are most at risk if you:

- Have had a fall in the last 12 months
- Fall was a result of collapse/faint/dizziness
- Feel unsteady mobilising or have problems with balance
- Have balance, hearing or vision problems
- Are taking 4 or more medicines

The risk of falls may increase further at the moment due to social distancing. It may have an impact on your ability to stay active, eat healthily and access your usual support networks.

It's important to remember that local health services are still accessible and you should report any falls, even if you are not injured, to your GP. If you are concerned about a relative or friend you can also call us for advice.
