

And finally:- "Do as I say, not as I do". How different this statement is to what the saints, and of course, our Lord Jesus said. Often this statement does come from a dissatisfaction of one's own practice although used humorously; hidden within it is a cry, "I wish I was better". The Lord called the Pharisees hypocrites. Jesus, who could see what was in everyone's minds, was able to see their true intentions; that, they never really intended to practise what they preached. They were not convinced of their own teachings it seems. A person who is honestly trying to do the right thing but fails to live up to their own expectation, therefore, is not a hypocrite but someone on the road to sanctification. It is however, very important that we can do what we teach or believe to be right. Hopefully, we too can become like the saints and our Lord Jesus and thus say like St Paul, "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ."
