Dear Parents,

<u>Covid update</u>: Thank you to all parents, once more, for adopting a conscientious approach to the spread of the virus, which has been more prevalent in school again, this week. Please be aware that staff are vigilant in their approach- any raised temperature will be shared with parents, immediately. Please also remind your children about the importance of handwashing. Wherever possible, children will be outside in the air, whilst the weather holds. Our very best wishes to those in our school community who are unwell, currently, including our very resilient workforce.

Start and End of the day collection times. As social distancing is no longer required, we will be returning to a 3.15pm collection time for ALL of Y1-Y6 children each afternoon, from the gates they are already accessing. This will mean that Y1-Y6 children will not be dismissed until 3.15pm each day. We have trialled it this week- you may have noticed- and it will benefit staff and parents too, as it will reduce waiting times, in many cases. School will continue to start at 8.45am, with gates closing at 8.50am for Y1-Y6 children. There will be no change in arrival and finish times for Reception and Nursery children.
