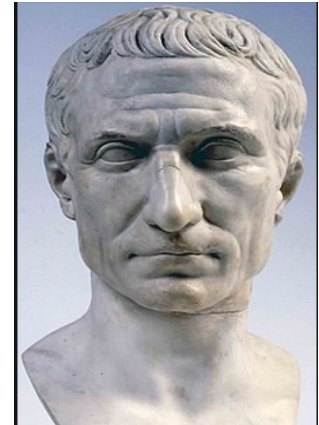


### Key Vocabulary and Spellings

Emperor	The leader of an empire. Similar to a king or queen.
Empire	A group of nations or peoples under one ruler or government.
Gladiator	A man who fought in an amphitheatre to entertain.
Invasion	Entering another land to take it over.
Legion	A unit of the Roman army.
Mosaic	A picture made of up of thousands of tiles.
Senate	The Roman government.

- The Romans invaded and conquered many countries in Europe before coming to Britain.
- Two brothers, Romulus and Remus fought and Romulus created Rome in his own name. The Roman empire started in Rome.
- The Romans invaded Britain partly because it had precious metals such as tin, lead, gold and silver.
- Boudicca was a member of the Iceni tribe who fought against the Romans..
- Julius Caesar, Claudius and Augustus are three of the better known Roman Emperors.
