Dear Parents,

- 2. Friday 12th February is an INSET Day Please remember school is closed now until Monday 22nd February. Thank you to all parents, grandparents, staff at all levels and children, who have worked really hard to engage with Remote Learning and within school, also. We look forward, to edging closer to a new normality soon after half term.
- 3. New security fencing work to commence during half term Please note the following changes to arrangements for collecting and dropping children into school from Monday 22nd February - Friday 5th March.
 - **a.** Reception and Nursery children will be greeted at the top of the entrance to the car park by staff at 8.45am (or for Nursery children of non critical workers 9.10am). They will then be escorted to their classrooms. Reception and Nursery children will be escorted to the entrance to the car park, each afternoon.
 - **D.** V3 children (and siblings) will be redirected to Cranleigh Close Entrance each a.m and p.m, temporarily.

In the meantime, Mrs Hayes and Mrs Heenan, supported by Fr Craig, are preparing a Y6 Confirmation parents' support video package, which will be posted onto the school website by Friday 26th February. If you wish your child to be confirmed, then you will need to log onto the videos and listen/act on the information. If you do not wish your child to be confirmed, but would also like to listen and take part in the celebration, then you are also welcome to log on. We have always been very explicit about the place of sacramental preparation for ALL, irrespective of faith, here at SMA, as indicated in the Home School Agreement. We have always been really proud of our non catholic, non Christian childrens' faith journeys alongside their peers. Long may that continue. Where children are openly disrespectful, I will be in touch for your full support in correcting their behaviour. Many thanks in anticipation. Rest assured, Fr Craig and Mrs Hayes/Mrs Heenan have a Plan B up their sleeves.
