Dear Parent(s),

I am delighted to inform you that our schools SMA Great British Green Bake Off will be taking place on Thursday 16th December 2021.

The purpose behind the Bake Off is to promote a green approach to all that we do. We want children to think about eating healthily, cooking healthily, buying locally and travelling in a way that is not harmful to the environment.

To enter, Pupils must pay the £1 entry fee and bring in one green cupcake. All cupcakes will be judged by Year 6 Head of School Council, the School Cooks, Mrs Kennedy and Mrs Murray.

Pupils must demonstrate, using the form below, that they have shopped locally and travelled to the shops in an environmentally friendly way (eg they have walked or cycled). Finally, they must demonstrate that their cake is a healthier cake- eg using less sugar and healthy ingredients, including free-range eggs.

Rules of Entry

- Pupils must pay £1 -which will be donated to charity.
- Pupils must bring one cupcake into school.
- Cup cakes must follow the green theme (green icing, green sponge, etc)
- Cup cakes should be brought into school on the day of the Bake Off, 16th December 2021 and not before
- Ingredients must come from local producers like Farm shops.
- The form below must be completed and demonstrate a green approach to the bake off
- After judging pupils will be allowed to take their cakes home if they last that long!
- All entries will receive a certificate and all entries will earn a batch of freshly cakes for their class on that afternoon
- Winners will be notified- with small prizes- in the following categories:
 - Most environmentally friendly
 - Most pleasing to look at
 - Most pleasing to taste
 - Best effort
