


Second Collection

Sacrament of the Sick



And finally:- The history of salvation begins with the choice of a man, Abraham, and a people, Israel, but its scope is universal, the salvation of all peoples. The history of salvation has always been marked by this interweaving of particularity and universality. We see this connection clearly in today's First Reading: on seeing in Cornelius' home the faith of the Gentiles and their desire for God, St. Peter says: "Truly I perceive that God shows no partiality, but in every nation and one who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him". Learning to fear God and practice justice thus opens the world to the Kingdom of God: this is the most profound purpose of all interreligious dialogue. (Benedict XVI)
